The Time Is Now! Stepping Over into Divine Fulfillment & Destiny

"Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preaching to you before, whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began." (Acts 3:19–21)

I. This Is That!

Words have been spoken for around 40 years concerning the billion-soul harvest, especially of youth and the beginning of the Great Harvest. But were there ever any authentic details given with these prophetic words, and have there been any conditions met and clear demarcations crossed so we can with confidence say, "This is the beginning of that"?

Where are we right now? We are moving from one era in the Spirit to the next. The conditions to the prophetic words have been met. I am now boldly proclaiming, "This is that spoken by the holy prophets of old!" I can say with full assurance, "The time is now" and "This is that! It is the beginning of the Great Harvest!"

II. The Time of Great Transition!

We're at a key moment of transition as we cross into the Hebrew year of 5784! We're moving out of the old and into the new. I believe it's important to understand the Hebrew meaning of the numbers 5784. Here are some of the meanings behind the Hebrew numbers 5784:

- **5 (Hey)** Often represents grace, divine goodness, and occasionally judgment or refinement.
- **7 (Zayin)** Can symbolize completion reminiscent of the 7th day of creation and likewise denote spiritual rest.
- 8 (Chet) Embodies new beginnings, transformation, and the spirit of revival.
- **4 (Dalet)** Can stand for doorways or foundations. It also can represent the four corners of the earth.

In this Hebrew New Year, I believe God is cleansing us. This may feel unpleasant, but it's a necessary cleansing, enabling us to step into all God has for us this year. So I have a word for you. You might feel like you're stewarding something that's very small and you have a dream, that your life matters. Yes, I have a word for you. Your life matters, and what you have in your heart matters. Put your hand to the plow and don't give up! Do your skill with all your heart, and do not despise the day of a small beginning.

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Whatever you do, do with all your heart unto the Lord, because it really matters. It really, really does.

III. Key Words for the Times

A. The Rise of the Mordecai's

It is time for the Mordecai's to arise and to prepare the corporate Esther for her strategic and critical appointment.

B. The Call for a Global Esther Movement

Put your ears on and listen to this verse again. "If you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance for the Jews will arise from another place, but you and your father's family will perish." Now, here's the phrase I want us to capture together for this modern-day Global Esther Moment: "You have come to your royal position for such a time as this." (Esther 4:14)

In this Global Esther Moment, we are called to pray for Jerusalem, Israel, and the Middle East. Jerusalem is mentioned 181 times by name in the Bible and is the only city by name we are commanded to pray for by name. According to Zechariah 12:2–3, Jerusalem is called a "heavy stone." The question must be asked, "Is this more than just a parable? We need to answer the ultimate question in this crucial season, "What shall we do?"

C. Dial 911 - The Holy Spirit Border Patrol Guard

In our **Global Prayer Storm**, we host a live prayer time every Wednesday at noon CST on Social Media using Facebook and YouTube to prayer through various themes with trained intercessors and participants from around the globe. This is Spirit led and Spirit empowered prayer grounded in the Word of God.

Through the leading of the Holy Spirit, our team was warned that there were terrorist cells that had invaded the United States of America in key locations. Through dreams and visions, the Lord called us to prayer for a Holy Spirit Border Patrol Guard across the southern border of the United States, and to continue to pray for the Holy Spirit Border Patrol Guard around the nation of Israel on land, sea, and by air.

We have been calling forth Michael, the chief Warrior Archangel, to release his warrior angels for divine protection across our borders. We have encouraged people to do prayer walks in their own neighborhoods again. We have been encouraging our GEM intercessors to pray-read Psalm 91 and other scriptures. We declare that the "shields of the earth belong to God" but there are greater weapons in the Spirit that are not carnal but mighty to destroy strongholds, in

Jesus' name.

D. Giant Slayers Will Come Forth

The theme scriptures come from Numbers 14:24 and Numbers 13:33. Caleb had a different spirit and thus his generation dispossessed the giants that were in the land and fully inherited the promises. I was given a vivid dream in which I was told, "Your enemies shall become like grasshoppers in your own sight!" So arise! It is time for Giant Slayers to come forth.

It has to start somewhere, and you can be the next Giant Slayer in your generational family tree. Yes, you can! **Get ready, because your revival breakthrough is coming!**

E. The Suddenlies of God

"I will send My messenger, who will prepare the way before Me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to His temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come,' says the Lord Almighty." (Malachi 3:1)

Revivals happen suddenly. They often include unexpected people, in unexpected places, being used by God in unexpected ways. These revivals can appear overnight as God quickly returns to His temple.

During these visions I heard God say, "If you can rock the campuses, you can rock the nations." I believe a global outpouring is coming to college campuses that will touch the world.

F. Wars and Rumors of Wars

When asked if I see WWIII fully happening right now I say, according to Matthew 25 there will be wars and rumors of wars. I have not seen one huge World War taking place at this time, but I see multiple regional wars taking place all at the same time.

Of course this has already begun in the Ukraine. I was given dreams

concerning Crimea at least 20 years ago. I heard a voice being raised, "Come and help us." No one would come, but the Mother Bear of the North, waking up and starting to swing her paw at the southern former satellite countries and attempt to bring them under her control for the sake of gaining back control of the Black Sea. I saw the war breaking out in the Ukraine and I have warned rabbis and leaders of such.

I have written out the current conflict in the Gaza Strip in my book, "The Mystery of Israel and the Middle East." I believe that we could be in the midst of Psalm 83:3–5 unfolding. This easily could not be a one-front war, but a three- to four-front war. But prayer turns the tide.

We must watch and pray over the water ways and rights around the Philippines, not just Taiwan. We must watch and pray over the Alaskan Island chain. There are different types of warfare that can be fought today. There is ground warfare, warfare by sea and by air, but there is also cyberspace and other technological forms of war that we have not previously considered as war. We must wise up!

IV. Pray for the Prophets – Honor the Prophets

I have felt called by the Lord to launch an annual **Day to Pray for the Prophets**. Just as there is a Sunday set aside to pray for our pastors, a Sunday to pray for the persecuted Church, the National Day of Prayer on the first Thursday of May, and the day to pray for the peace of Jerusalem is the first Sunday in October each year and many other important emphases in the Church, Jewish and national calendar, etc., I feel it could be one of my major contributions, along with others, to bring to the Body of Christ a day to pray for the prophets.

I have therefore procured the domain names of **PrayfortheProphets.com** as well as **HonortheProphets.com**. I believe that the Day to Pray for the Prophets is not to be held on a Sunday, though, so as not to be seen in competition with pastors and the local church. This is initially being launched through our **Global Prayer Storm**. I am developing a task force which is helping me shape this new thrust. The special day will be held on a Friday once a year with prayer tools that will be

developed and distributed. The specific Friday is yet to be selected.

I want to introduce this first to the spheres that I am involved in: ACPE, HIM, and other prayer networks and apostolic spheres of influence, and then into other spheres of influence in the wider Body of Christ and see where the Holy Spirit will take this over time.

I see this growing into a movement of "Honoring the Prophets" where a foundation will be established to fund prophets throughout the globe to do the work of the Kingdom.

V. Come to Me, Come to Me, O, Come to Me!

In the gospel of Matthew, chapter 11, we find a timeless message of comfort and peace. These verses provide a source of inspiration for individuals seeking solace and rest amidst the challenges of life.
